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This letter is being sent to inform you of construction activity on the abovereferenced project.

The contractor is tentatively scheduled to begin tree removals on the 2025 Hennepin Avenue (CSAH 2) Street and Utility Improvement Project the week of February 24, 2025, in preparation for street and utility construction that will occur this spring/summer.

Tree removal is necessary for various reasons to accommodate the reconstruction project such as:

- Drain tile and new curb and gutter construction (trees are too close to the road)
- Water service construction (8 foot deep trench next to or under current tree would require significant root and/or trunk damage)
- Sanitary sewer service construction (8 foot deep trench next to or under current tree would require significant root and/or trunk damage)

Efforts were made during the design of the project to preserve various trees that are not ash trees nor are in conflict with the proposed reconstruction project.

Trees that are to be removed will be marked for removal this week. The contractor will have flaggers, signs, and cones on site while performing the work. It is anticipated that the work will take approximately 5 days to complete.

Please remember that schedules can change at a moment's notice because of weather or other unforeseen events.
